

[Tips for speakers]

The success of your speech also depends on the interaction between you and the interpreters.

- » Let the interpreters have as much information as possible.
- » Always speak into a microphone. Otherwise the interpreters cannot hear you.
- » Allow a short pause before moving from one idea to the next.
- » Try to maintain a neutral, objective speaking style.
- » Avoid making jokes altogether in an international context.

... and one more request

Do switch off your mobile phones. They cause considerable sound interference and produce irritating noises in the headphones of the interpreters and the audience.
